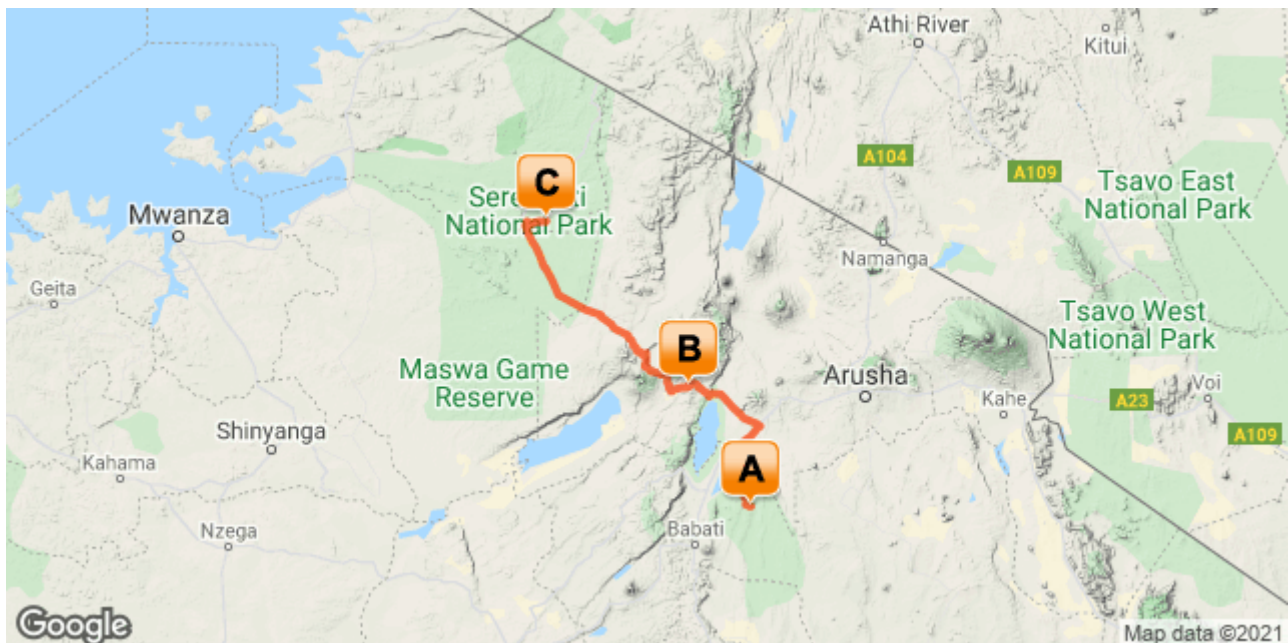




Special Migration

Tarangire - Karatu -Manyara- Ngorongoro-Central Serengeti - North Serengeti
7 Days / 6 Nights



Day 1: Ang'ata Tarangire Camp, Tarangire National Park



After the Serengeti, Tarangire has the greatest concentration of wildlife in Tanzania and in the dry season the Tarangire River is a magnet for thirsty wildlife. Large herds of elephants and migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest and eland gather and not surprisingly the predators follow. This is also the one place in Tanzania where dry-country antelope such as oryx and gerenuk are regularly spotted. Tarangire is also known for its spectacular baobab trees, and its breathtaking views of the Masaai Steppe and the mountains to the south. Located just a few hours drive from the town of Arusha, Tarangire is a popular stop for safaris travelling through the northern circuit on their way to Ngorongoro and the Serengeti. The park extends into two game controlled areas and the wildlife are allowed to move freely throughout.

Day Itinerary

Karibuni Tanzania!

Arriving at Kilimanjaro International Airport and transfer by private vehicle to the lodge located within the Tarangire National Park which is 3.5 hours away.

Upon arrival at the entrance to the Tarangire national park, safari on route until you arrive to your lodge located one hour from the entrance. Arrival at the camp where lunch will be served and in the afternoon departure for a safari

Overnight: Ang'ata Tarangire Camp

Ang'ata Tarangire Camp features 8 guest tents, including a 2 tent family unit, a lounge and a dining tent. Each guest tent has an en suite bathroom with shower and vanity desk. The camp lounge is the place to meet other travelers and share safari stories while enjoying a complimentary cup of Tanzanian coffee or tea. Breakfasts, lunches and dinners are served in the dining tent, freshly prepared on a daily basis. Bush TV, the local name for campfire, is lit when the weather permits.

Day 2: Pamoja Olea Farm Lodge, Karatu



Travelers heading to the Serengeti and Ngorongoro Crater will inevitably pass through the city of Karatu, in the green hills of the northern highlands of Tanzania. Presided over by the mighty Ol Deani Volcano, this colorful little town serves as a popular night stop for visitors exploring the area's many game parks. The city offers a variety of activities including exploring the bustling market, tasting beer at a local brewery, visiting a traditional Iraqi farm, or taking a guided walk through the Ngorongoro Forest in search of waterfalls and elephant caves. Whether they are looking for cultural tours, excursions and cycling, the opportunity to enjoy an authentic rural experience in Tanzania, or simply a break between safaris, this underrated city has a lot to offer

Day Itinerary

After breakfast, departure to Mto Wa Mbu for an excursion along the shores of Lake Manyara.

Upon arrival in Mto wa Mbu you can enjoy a memorable scenic and cultural excursion by tuk tuk or bicycle through the nearby community of Mto wa Mbu, organized by an expert guide. Begin your adventure by traveling through this bustling town and interacting with its friendly people.

After your tuk tuk tour, safari on Lake Manyara including lunch.

Lake Manyara National Park is one of the smallest National Parks but very beautiful with tremendous diversity of habitats, animals and especially birds. The park covers about 330 Kms² where by one third of the park is land and the remainder being part of Lake Manyara.

Lake Manyara National Park is known for its tree-climbing lions, hippo pools and thousands of flamingos which give the lake a hazy pink tint. Here you can spot fish eagles, elephants, giraffes and the largest concentration of baboons anywhere in the world. Lake Manyara is the ideal location for a game drive because of its many ecosystems.

After your game drive proceed to your accommodation for dinner and overnight

Overnight: Pamoja Olea Farm Lodge

The lodge perfectly located between the Tarangire and Lake Manyara National Parks on one side and Ngorongoro Conservation Area and Serengeti National Park on the other, this is a great base from which to experience these world-famous reserves as well as enjoy many other adventurous activities in the Region.

From the mighty Big Five- Lions, Leopard, Buffalo, Elephant and Rhino to the tenacious dung Beetle, Elephant shrew, Buffalo Weaver, Leopard tortoise, Rhinoceros beetle, Antlion, from thousands of Butterflies to the Great Migration in Serengeti.

Discover the night skies like you never see before – a billion stars hanging low over your head, almost close enough to touch.

Stand at the edge of Ngorongoro forest and enjoy the risen plateau with Karatu fertile farm land and its Kushi people.

Day 3: Pamoja Olea Farm Lodge, Karatu



Day Itinerary

After an early breakfast drive to Ngorongoro Crater for game drive safari on the crater floor of Ngorongoro. Ngorongoro Crater is a natural wonder of the world and is 20 km in diameter with its own ecosystem due to its enclosed nature.

On Game drive you will spot a lush highland forest, with magnificent birdlife among the different tree species. Once on the grassy crater floor, you may discover a large variety of grazing herbivores, as well as the predators that are attracted by this abundant supply of prey. If you are after **The Big Five**, it is all here waiting for you. Black rhino, Tuskers elephants, lion, leopard and hyena along with healthy herds of wildebeest, buffalo and zebra. The Ngorongoro Crater has the biggest tusked elephants in Tanzania and is home to one of the few concentrated populations of Rhino. The Ngorongoro Conservation Area is famous not only for its beauty and wildlife, but also for the fact that it allows human habitation. The local Maasai tribe still lives within the area.

In the afternoon have your picnic hamper lunch in the crater

After your game drive return to the lodge for dinner and overnight

Day 4: Mbugani Camps - Seronera Camp, Central Serengeti



The Serengeti together with Kenya's Masai Mara Game Park form Africa's most famous wildlife park. The image of acacia trees on an endless grass plain epitomises Africa for many, and then add a Masai warrior and some cattle to the picture and the conversation need go no further. The annual wildebeest migration through the Serengeti and the Masai Mara is the largest mass movement of land mammals on the planet – with more than a million animals following the rains. But that is not where the game viewing ends; large prides of lions, elephants and giraffes in grasslands, gazelles and eland to mention but a few. Aside from traditional vehicle safaris, hot-air ballooning over the Serengeti plains has become almost essential and you can even do a horseback safari.

Day Itinerary

Breakfast and check-out from the lodge. Continue your adventure as you drop over the Western rim of the Crater and onto the endless plains of the Serengeti. Upon entering the Serengeti, you are able to game drive all the way to your lodge. Lunch at the camp and afternoon game drive.

Optional activity - Hot air Balloning. :

Enjoy a great experience of a hot air balloon safari. Depart before dawn to the launch site and experience the wakening of wildlife and beautiful sunrise. Upon arrival at the site you will meet your pilot who will demonstrate all necessary safety information

The flight depends mostly on the weather and the wind, thus varies from day to day, but generally it is an hour's flight. On your flight you will experience an eagle's view of the Serengeti and all its beauty and if there is a special activity, the pilot will take the balloon near the treetops for better vision.

On landing, you will be served traditional toast of champagne, followed by breakfast. There is truly nothing to compare with breakfast served in the middle of the Serengeti plains.



Overnight: Mbugani Camps - Seronera Camp

Day 5: Mbugani Migration Camp, Northern Serengeti



The Serengeti together with Kenya's Masai Mara Game Park form Africa's most famous wildlife park. The image of acacia trees on an endless grass plain epitomises Africa for many, and then add a Masai warrior and some cattle to the picture and the conversation need go no further. Unlike the southern plains of the Serengeti that dry out, forcing all but the hardiest of species to leave, the Northern Serengeti remains lush and green throughout the year. The annual wildebeest migration through the Serengeti and the Masai Mara is the largest mass movement of land mammals on the planet – with more than a million animals following the rains. From July through to October the Migration is in the Northern Serengeti and this is where many of the most famous scenes of the Migration occur with almost daily crossings of the Mara River. But that is not where the game viewing ends; large prides of lions, elephants and giraffes in grasslands, gazelles and eland to mention but a few.

Day Intinary

Breakfast and departure to the north of the Serengeti safari and lunch on route. you will arrive at your accommodation and prepare for dinner.

Overnight: Mbugani Migration Camp

Mbugani Camps is located in Bologonja, north of Serengeti National Park. This semipermanent camp is open year round to offer clients prime gamewatching and full immersion in nature in a safe, serene, and home-like setting. Day 6: Mbugani Migration Camp, Northern Serengeti



Day Itinerary

Have a full day to experience of game drive in the northern part of Serengeti National Park.

Stretching from Seronera for about 100 km north, to the Kenyan border is the Northern Serengeti. It is characterized by green rolling hills and thickly vegetated granite outcrops and a good permanent population of wildlife in several areas here, including the very beautiful Lobo Kopje.

Game drive is not as prolific as the central and southern regions of the Serengeti but from around August to October the migrating herds move through the area to cross the Mara River on their way to the Masai Mara. This is the time to visit the Northern Serengeti: dramatic scenes ensue as tens of thousands of animals plunge into the river in a desperate attempt to reach the other side before the river's enormous crocodiles home in on them

After your game drive return to the camp for dinner and overnight
